Sub.: Intimation under Regulation 51 read with Schedule III of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015:

Dear Sir/Madam,

Pursuant to Regulation 51 read with Schedule III of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI Listing Regulations"), we wish to inform you that the equity shares of Manipal Health Enterprises Limited ("MHEL"), the holding company of Manipal Hospitals Private Limited ("Company"), were listed on the recognised stock exchanges i.e. on BSE Limited ("BSE") and National Stock Exchange of India Limited ("NSE") with effect from Wednesday, August 5, 2026.

Further in continuation to the disclosure made in the Key Information Document ("KID") and the Debenture Trust Deed ("DTD") governing the Company's Non-Convertible Debentures ("NCDs"), filed with BSE on September 15, 2025 the proceeds from the Initial Public Offering ("IPO") of MHEL are proposed to be utilised towards the redemption of the outstanding NCDs of the Company. The Prospectus of MHEL dated July 31, 2026 also contain the aforesaid disclosure regarding the proposed utilisation of the IPO proceeds.

Accordingly, the listing of MHEL pursuant to its IPO constitutes a "Mandatory Redemption Event" in terms of the KID and the DTD filed with BSE on September 15, 2025. Consequently, the Company shall redeem the outstanding NCDs within the timeline specified under the KID and the DTD and in accordance with the terms and conditions governing the NCDs.

The Company shall make such further disclosures, including the record date and redemption date, as may be required under the SEBI Listing Regulations and other applicable laws.

We request you to please take the same on record.
