## Definitions

Terms	Description
<b>Applicable Law(s)</b>	Applicable Law(s) means any applicable constitution, treaty, statute, rule, regulation, ordinance, order, directive, code, interpretation, judgment, decree, injunction, writ, determination, award, permit, license, authorization, requirement or decision of or agreement with or by any legislative, administrative, judicial or other governmental authority.
<b>Applicable Privacy Laws</b>	Applicable Privacy Laws means all Applicable Laws concerning privacy, data security, or data protection that apply to a Partner or its activities under the DPA, including but not limited to Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023, Information Technology Act, 2000, Information Technology (Reasonable security practices and procedures and sensitive personal data or information) Rules, 2011
<b>Board</b>	Data Protection Board of India, established by the Central Government
<b>Consent</b>	Any freely given, specific, informed, and unambiguous indication, through a statement or clear affirmative action, of the Data Principal's Agreement to the Processing of his or her personal data.
<b>Consent Manager</b>	A person registered with the Data Protection Board who acts as a single point of contact to enable a Data Principal to give, manage, review, and withdraw her consent through an accessible, transparent, and interoperable platform.
<b>Data Fiduciary or Fiduciary</b>	The person who determines the purposes and means of the Personal Data Processing. It is implied that a "person" means a "natural or legal person" as per India DPDP Act, or "(i) an individual; (ii) a Hindu undivided family; (iii) a company; (iv) a firm; (v) an association of persons or a body of individuals, whether incorporated or not; (vi) the State; and (vii) every artificial juristic person, not falling within any of the preceding sub-clauses" as per India DPDP Act
<b>Data Processor or Processor</b>	The person which processes Personal Data on behalf of the Fiduciary. It is implied that a "person" means a "natural or legal person" as per India DPDP Act, or "(i) an individual; (ii) a Hindu undivided family; (iii) a company; (iv) a firm; (v) an association of persons or a body of individuals, whether incorporated or not; (vi) the State; and (vii) every artificial juristic person, not falling within any of the preceding sub-clauses" as per India DPDP Act

<b>Data Processing Agreement “DPA”</b>	DPA shall mean The Data Processing Agreement signed by Manipal Health Enterprises Pvt Ltd and the Data Processor or Processor
<b>Data Principal</b>	A natural person identified or identifiable, directly, or indirectly, by reference to an identifier, such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier, or to one or more factors specific to his or her physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural, or social identity, whose Personal Data are being processed.
<b>Data Sub Processor</b>	The person who processes Personal Data on behalf of data processor. It is implied that a “person” means a “natural or legal person” as per India DPDP Act, or “(i) an individual; (ii) a Hindu undivided family; (iii) a company; (iv) a firm; (v) an association of persons or a body of individuals, whether incorporated or not; (vi) the State; and (vii) every artificial juristic person, not falling within any of the preceding sub-clauses” as per India DPDP Act
<b>Documentation of processing</b>	A document which is maintained in an electronic form by an entity as a Fiduciary, or a Processor and including a list of information as required under Applicable Data Protection Laws describing all Personal Data Processing activities carried out.
<b>Employees</b>	Manipal Health Enterprises Pvt Ltd and its subsidiaries full-time employees, part-time employees, interns and contractors, vendors or other third-party employees retained by Manipal Health Enterprises Pvt Ltd under an outsourcing contract.
<b>Master Agreement</b>	Master Agreement shall mean the principal agreement executed by the Parties to render <TBU> services to the Data Fiduciary, due to which the processing of the Personal Data mentioned in this DPA occurs.
<b>Personal Data</b>	Any information relating to a Data Principal and shall have the meaning set out in the Applicable Data Protection Laws and Regulations Framework as updated from time to time.
<b>Personal Data Breach</b>	Any unauthorized processing of personal data or accidental disclosure, acquisition, sharing, use, alteration, destruction, or loss of access to personal data, that compromises the confidentiality, integrity, or availability of personal data.
<b>Process or Processing</b>	Wholly or partly automated operation or set of operations performed on digital personal data, and includes operations such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation, retrieval, use, alignment, or combination, indexing, sharing, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, restriction, erasure or destruction
<b>Significant Data Fiduciary</b>	Any Data Fiduciary or class of Data Fiduciaries on the basis of assessment of relevant factors such as the volume and sensitivity of personal data processed, risk to the rights of the

	Data Principal, potential impact on the sovereignty and integrity of India, risk to electoral democracy, security of the State, and public order.
<b>Third party</b>	A natural or legal person carrying out any business offering technical or non-technical support services to Manipal Health Enterprises Pvt Ltd and its subsidiaries and may include service providers who shall act as Data Processors/Data Sub Processors.
<b>The Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023</b>	An Act enacted by the Government of India and any corresponding rules and regulations to provide protection for the processing of digital personal data in a manner that recognizes both the right of individuals to protect their personal data and the need to process such Personal Data for lawful purposes and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.
