Overview

Dr. Abhijit Agashe is a renowned orthopaedic surgeon with 23 years of experience and is recognized among the top five orthopaedic surgeons in Pune at Manipal Hospital, Baner. He specializes in joint replacement surgeries and sports injury management, with expertise in robotic-assisted procedures. Having performed over 800 robotic knee replacements, he was the first in Pune to successfully conduct a Robotic-Assisted Direct Anterior Hip Replacement. His skills extend to complex revision joint surgeries, as well as shoulder, elbow, and ankle replacements, making him a leader in advanced orthopaedic care. Dr. Agashe completed his MBBS from the University of Pune in 2000, followed by an MS in Orthopaedics in 2004. He further earned a DNB in Orthopedics/Orthopedic Surgery from the National Board of Examination in 2005. To enhance his expertise, he pursued prestigious international fellowships, including a Joint Replacement Fellowship under Prof. J.D. Chang in Seoul, South Korea, a Fellowship in Sports Medicine & Arthroscopic Surgery with Prof. Wolf Peterson in Germany, and the FASIF Swiss Fellowship at AO Foundation, Switzerland, specializing in trauma and pelvic-acetabular injuries. With his

dedication to research and innovation, Dr. Agashe has received numerous accolades. He was honoured with the Research Award by Bone and Joint Decade (2004) and an Esteemed Fellowship by AO Group, Switzerland (2008). Additionally, he completed a Fellowship in Sports Medicine in Germany (2007) and a Joint Replacement Clinical Fellowship in South Korea (2008). His outstanding research contributions also earned him the WHO scholarship for the Bone and Joint Decade initiative from 2001-2010. Dr. Agashe has made significant contributions to medical literature, with multiple publications in reputed journals. His notable works include research on "Concurrent Femoral Neck Fracture with Avascular Necrosis of the Femoral Head" (Journal of Clinical Orthopaedics, 2010) and "Femoral Artery Injuries during Revision Hip Replacement" (JBJS American). He has also authored a chapter on venous thromboembolism in joint replacement in the APAS book (2018) and discussed the use of factor Xa inhibitors in preventing VTE in an open-source journal (2021).
