He later broadened his expertise by acquiring a Diplomate of National Board (DNB) in Genito-Urinary Surgery from the National Board of Examinations (NBE). He has also been a visiting fellow at prestigious international institutions, namely the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) and the Mayo Clinic in Rochester. Dr. Das's academic prowess is evident from his achievement of ranking 28th in the All India PG Medical Entrance Examination in 1998 and receiving honours in Microbiology, solidifying his reputation as a dedicated and accomplished scholar in the medical field. Dr. Das excels at conducting Kidney Transplantation Surgeries by employing cutting-edge techniques. He is also proficient in employing advanced

Medical College and winning second prize for best video presentation at the Urological Society of India Conference, North Zone (NZUSICON).
