Her work includes a detailed study on "Interstitial Pneumonia with Autoimmune Features" published in the Indian Journal of Rheumatology, 2021 and a diagnostic case study titled "Wolf in sheep's skin...Is it AOSD? A diagnostic dilemma!!!" in the APIK Journal of Internal Medicine in 2017. Some of her other published works include - "Assessing Osteoporosis Risk in Patients with RA - Role of Annual Review", "Unusual Cause of Hip Pain", "Polyarticular Pain in Patients with Rheumatoid Arthritis", and more.
