### **Overview**

Her early professional development includes a Trauma Care Internship at Tan Tock Seng Hospital, Singapore, where she underwent Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) training. This international exposure strengthened her clinical approach to emergency medicine, acute stabilisation, and protocol-based management of critically ill patients. The experience enhanced her confidence in rapid clinical assessment, multidisciplinary coordination, and structured emergency response, all of which continue to inform her present-day medical practice. Dr. Kruthika has worked across diverse healthcare environments, including tertiary care hospitals, emergency departments, and government healthcare institutions. She served as a Casualty Medical Officer, managing a wide range of cardiac and medical emergencies, supervising acute stabilisation protocols, coordinating referrals, and performing continuous monitoring of critically ill patients. Her responsibilities included managing acute coronary syndromes, metabolic emergencies, severe infections, and neurological presentations, along with performing both medical and electrical cardioversion where indicated. She later served as a Specialist Physician at Doddaballapur General Hospital, Bangalore Rural, where she independently managed high-volume outpatient services and inpatient wards. In this role, she provided comprehensive medical evaluations, formulated treatment protocols, monitored chronic illnesses, and counseled patients and families on medication adherence, lifestyle modification, and long-term disease planning. She was also actively involved in structured healthcare delivery under public health programmes, contributing to preventive screening initiatives and continuity-of-care models in community-based medicine.
