Overview

has also held numerous prestigious leadership positions that have contributed to shaping his professional career as well as served numerous patients. As Consultant and Head of Unit, Medical Oncology at Action Cancer Hospital, Paschim Vihar, Delhi, and earlier as Consultant in Medical Oncology at RGCI&RC, he has played a leading role in defining cancer treatment protocols, mentoring younger doctors, and implementing new therapies. His work has spanned the management of solid tumours—including breast, lung, gastrointestinal, and genitourinary cancers—as well as haematological malignancies such as leukaemia, lymphoma, and myeloma.
