Overview

Dr. Sumanta Chatterjee is an esteemed consultant cardiologist in the Department of Cardiology at Manipal Hospitals, Dhakuria, Kolkata. He pursued his medical education at Medical College, Kolkata, where he earned Gold Medals for his exceptional performance during both his Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) and Doctor of Medicine (MD) in Medicine studies, and notably topped the institution in the Doctorate of Medicine (DM) in Cardiology. He further enriched his expertise by earning a fellowship from the Society for Coronary Angiography and Intervention (FSCAI), and being an associate fellow of the European Society of Cardiology (AFESC). Proficient in a wide array of procedures, Dr. Chatterjee specialises in Radial Route Angiography and Angioplasty, with a particular focus on Primary Angioplasty. He also demonstrates expertise in advanced techniques such as Fractional Flow Reserve (FFR), Optical Coherence Tomography (OCT), and Intravascular Ultrasound (IVUS) guidance for Angioplasties, addressing complex coronary conditions, including bifurcation lesions, with cutting-edge technology. Moreover, Dr. Chatterjee is skilled in various interventions, including Pacemaker Implantation, Implantable

Cardioverter Defibrillator (ICD), and Cardiac Resynchronisation Therapy (CRT) implantations. His proficiency extends to performing Echocardiography, both Transthoracic Echocardiography (TTE) and Transesophageal Echocardiography (TEE), Balloon Mitral, and Pulmonary Valvuloplasty. He utilises specialised Microcatheters like Coronary Sinus Angiography and Right Heart (CORSAIR) and Total Revascularisation using novel devices and techniques. Dr. Chatterjee is a distinguished member and fellow of several esteemed societies, including the Cardiological Society of India (CSI), the Association of Physicians of India (API), the American College of Cardiology (ACC), the Heart Failure Society of America (HFSA), and the Indian Academy of Clinical Medicine (IACM). His extensive affiliations with many professional organisations, coupled with his extensive publications in many peer-reviewed journals, underscore his commitment to advancing Cardiovascular Medicine. Dr. Chatterjee also shows a keen interest in emerging technologies such as Leadless Pacemaker Implantation, Subcutaneous ICD, Left Atrial Appendage (LAA) Closure, and Transcatheter Aortic Valve Replacement (TAVR) procedures. Additionally, Dr. Chatterjee is proficient in English, Bengali, and Hindi, ensuring seamless communication and fostering strong doctor-patient relationships.
