Overview

Dr. (Air Cmde) Vikas Kulshrestha is an experienced orthopaedic surgeon in Electronic City with more than 33 years of experience in orthopaedic surgery and joint reconstruction. He is currently practising as a Consultant – Orthopaedics, Manipal Hospital Electronic City, with expertise in joint replacement, sports and trauma surgery, knee preservation, complex joint reconstruction, and revision arthroplasty. Having performed more than 18,000 orthopaedic surgeries, Dr. Vikas Kulshrestha possesses master-level expertise in Oxford partial knee replacement, robotic joint replacement, reverse shoulder arthroplasty, complex pelvi-acetabular trauma reconstruction, and sports medicine. His surgical mastery and military clinical leadership establish him as one of the most experienced orthopaedic surgeons in Electronic City. Dr. Vikas Kulshrestha completed his MBBS and MS in Orthopaedics, subsequently undertook advanced international training in joint replacement, trauma surgery, computer-assisted and robotic surgery, clinical investigation and documentation, and revision arthroplasty. He

has extensive experience in partial knee replacement and has performed more than 2,000 such procedures. His expertise in Oxford partial knee replacement has also led to his role as an instructor in the technique for approximately a decade. He also specialises in reverse shoulder arthroplasty and has developed extensive experience in managing complex shoulder conditions requiring joint replacement. At Manipal Hospital Electronic City, Dr. Vikas Kulshrestha's expertise in joint replacement extends to hip, knee, shoulder, and elbow surgery. He manages primary, complex, and revision arthroplasty, with specialised experience in revision joint replacement. His international training in revision arthroplasty has further strengthened his ability to approach challenging cases involving previous joint replacement surgery. Dr. Kulshrestha is also experienced in complex orthopaedic trauma and reconstruction. His training at major European trauma centres has provided specialised expertise in pelvi-acetabular trauma, complex skeletal trauma, and reconstruction requiring fragment-specific fixation. Dr. Vikas has combined clinical practice with academic research, medical education, and healthcare leadership. He has contributed to more than 50 peer-reviewed publications in national and international journals and has been involved in multiple randomised controlled trials. He has contributed to the development of checklists and clinical care pathways for international organisations. He has also served as a research consultant for the AO Foundation and has been recognised as a Professor and Examiner of Orthopaedics under the National Medical Commission framework. His academic and professional achievements have earned him several honours, including gold medals during his medical and postgraduate training. He received the Gold Medal in Physiology, the Gold Medal in Pathology, the Gold Medal in Surgery, and the Brigadier K. D. Khare Gold Medal in MS Orthopaedics. With extensive experience in joint replacement surgery, Dr. Vikas Kulshrestha combines advanced arthroplasty expertise with sports surgery, trauma care, joint preservation, and complex reconstruction. His approach is grounded in careful clinical

assessment, evidence-based decision-making, and selecting the most appropriate surgical or non-surgical strategy for each patient. He communicates in English and Hindi, supporting clear and accessible interaction throughout the treatment journey.
