Dr. Gambhir has been recognised for her professional contribution, including the Best Station Medicare Centre award in 2012, received during her service as a Senior Medical Officer. She remains engaged with developments in medical care and evidence-based clinical practice, with an emphasis on comprehensive assessment and appropriate health management.
