Overview

Dr. Shyam Duvuru is a highly accomplished neurosurgeon in Electronic City with more than 13 years of experience in advanced neurosurgical and spinal care. He is currently practising as a Senior Consultant – Neurosurgery at Manipal Hospital Electronic City, Bengaluru, with expertise in neuro-oncology, skull base surgery, cerebrovascular surgery, paediatric neurosurgery, epilepsy and functional neurosurgery, minimally invasive brain surgery, spine surgery, neurocritical care, and intraoperative neurophysiology, making him one of the best neurosurgeons in Electronic City. Dr. Shyam Duvuru completed his MBBS, followed by an MS in General Surgery and an MCh. He further pursued specialised international training in cerebrovascular surgery, advanced skull base neurosurgery, intraoperative neurophysiology, advanced microneurosurgery, and stroke and transcranial Doppler. His professional credentials include International Fellow of the American Association of Neurological Surgeons (IFAANS), Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (FACS), and FCVS (Japan). At Manipal Hospital Electronic City, Dr. Shyam Duvuru specialises in brain and spine tumour surgery, with particular

expertise in neuro-oncology and skull base procedures. His experience includes minimally invasive neurosurgical approaches and advanced intraoperative monitoring to support surgical precision and patient safety. Dr. Shyam Duvuru has extensive expertise in cerebrovascular neurosurgery in Electronic City, including the surgical management of complex cerebral aneurysms and arteriovenous malformations (AVMs). His practice also includes cerebral revascularisation and bypass procedures for selected patients with conditions such as Moyamoya disease and cerebrovascular disorders. Dr. Duvuru's expertise extends to paediatric neurosurgery, as he manages congenital neurological malformations and paediatric brain and spine tumours, with a specialised approach suited to the clinical and developmental needs of children. His research and publications have addressed conditions including cervical spinal instability, spinal tuberculosis, intramedullary tumours, and compressive myelopathy. His academic contributions are substantial, with more than 15 publications in high-impact national and international journals and over 30 scientific papers and posters presented at national and international conferences. Dr. Duvuru received the Apollo Innovation and Quality Award for Excellence in Clinical Services in 2023 for his contribution to an affordable brain tumour programme and the Apollo Clinical Award for Young Clinician in 2020 for his clinical, academic, and research contributions. His earlier achievements include the T.N. Dr. M.G.R. Medical University Gold Medal in Neurosurgery and Prof. S. Kalyanaraman Gold Medal in Neurosurgery.
