Medicine and Consultant Transplant Nephrologist at VCU Health, a premier high-volume US academic transplant centre performing approximately 350 kidney transplants annually. At Manipal Hospital Electronics City, Dr. Akshay Athreya's clinical expertise also includes managing conditions such as glomerulonephritis, IgA nephropathy, membranous nephropathy, focal segmental glomerulosclerosis, lupus nephritis, and ANCA-associated vasculitis. He manages patients with diabetic kidney disease and resistant hypertension, where careful assessment of renal function, cardiovascular risk, metabolic factors, and treatment response is essential for comprehensive care. He is experienced in the assessment of complex acute renal dysfunction, sepsis-associated kidney injury, cardiorenal syndromes, electrolyte abnormalities, acid-base disturbances, and patients requiring renal replacement therapy in critical care settings.
