He currently practices as a Consultant - Robotic, Laparoscopic Gastrointestinal & Bariatric Surgery at Manipal Hospital Electronics City, Bangalore. His extensive fellowship training and broad clinical experience have established him as one of the leading laparoscopic surgeons in Electronics City for advanced minimally invasive and gastrointestinal surgical care. Dr. Sunilkumar Alur completed his MBBS from M.R. Medical College, Gulbarga and earned his DNB in General Surgery from the National Board of Examinations (NBE), New Delhi. He is among the few surgeons holding an extensive array of prestigious surgical fellowships, including Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (FACS), Fellowship in Minimal Access Surgery (FMAS), Fellowship of the Indian Association of Gastrointestinal Endoscopists (FIAGES), Fellowship of the Association of Colorectal Surgeons of India (FACRSI), EFIAGES in Endoscopy, and FMIS from Rajiv
