He excels in life-saving interventions such as central venous catheter insertion (internal jugular, subclavian, femoral with or without ultrasound guidance), chest tube insertion, pericardiocentesis, and temporary pacemaker insertion (TPI). Dr. Manna is also adept at performing FAST scans, ECHO, arterial line insertions, and various orthopedic procedures like POP slab application, fracture reductions, and joint dislocation management. His expertise extends to critical emergency procedures, including pleural and peritoneal tapping, nasogastric tube insertion, urinary catheterization, arterial sampling, intravenous cannulations, wound closure, lumbar puncture, emergency deliveries,

foreign body removal, and thrombolysis in CVA & MI cases. Actively engaged in medical education, Dr. Manna leads community CPR programs, raising awareness and training the public in life-saving BLS techniques. He is a Lead Instructor for AHA-certified courses, including BLS, ACLS, and PALS, and has been instrumental in training EMTs, paramedics, nursing staff, and junior residents in ECG interpretation and emergency case management. His contributions to emergency medicine have been recognized through multiple certifications, including ACLS, BLS, and PALS Instructor credentials from AHA and ATLS training.
