Further, he specialized with a M.Ch. in Urology (Genitourinary Surgery) from the reputed and one of the most prestigious institute of Western India - Seth GS Medical College & KEM Hospital, Mumbai. Upon completion, he continued to work there as an Assistant Professor. Dr. Vyas possesses immense experience across multiple urological subspecialties, including Endourology, Uro-Oncology, Laparoscopic Surgeries, Renal Transplant, Female Urology, Paediatric Urology and Andrology, having successfully performed numerous surgeries in each area.
