Trained in high-volume centres, Dr. Borkar performs major gastrointestinal resections, oncological surgeries, minimally invasive procedures, and diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopies. His experience includes performing open and laparoscopic colorectal cancer resections, gastric and small-bowel resections, pancreatic procedures, and biliary surgeries for both benign and malignant conditions, as well as emergency gastrointestinal and acute abdomen surgery. In the field of minimally invasive surgery, Dr. Borkar performs laparoscopic gastrointestinal resections,

cholecystectomy, appendectomy, and hernia repair. He also participates in multidisciplinary tumour board discussions to determine the most effective treatment strategies for various gastrointestinal cancers.
