Overview

Dr. Nandini A. S is a distinguished dermatologist in Kanakapura Road, Bangalore known for her expertise in clinical dermatology, immunodermatology, biologic therapies, and chronic skin diseases requiring long-term care. She currently serves as a Consultant – Dermatology at Manipal Hospital Kanakapura Road, Bengaluru, where she combines evidence-based treatments with an empathetic and patient-centric approach. With more than 2 decades of experience, she is widely recognised for her work in managing complex immunodermatologic disorders (pemphigus and psoriasis), urticaria, autoimmune blistering disorders, and chronic hair and skin diseases. Dr. Nandini completed her MBBS from Kempegowda Institute of Medical Sciences (KIMS), Bangalore, and pursued her MD in Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy from JJM Medical College, Davangere, graduating as the top student in her batch. She further completed a Fellowship in Aesthetic Dermatology (FRGUHS) and holds an ACME certification in Medical Education, reflecting her dual focus on clinical excellence and academic leadership. Her training has shaped a career deeply rooted in ethical practice, scientific clarity, and

compassionate dermatology care. Known for her early advocacy and expertise in biologic therapies for immune-mediated skin disorders, Dr. Nandini has been instrumental in refining rituximab protocols for pemphigus in India. Her practice spans acne scars, hair disorders, vitiligo, lichen planus, macular amyloidosis, allergic skin conditions, and dermatologic manifestations of systemic illnesses, with a special focus on skin health in diverse Indian skin tones. Her practice is firmly rooted in ethical clarity and patient-first principles. She consistently emphasises that ethical conduct is not optional in medicine but a lived responsibility. Her reputation as an exceptional listener sets her apart. In a time when medical consultations are often rushed, Dr Nandini is known for allowing patients the time they need to articulate their concerns fully, medical, emotional or cosmetic. Patients often describe her as someone who never interrupts and never dismisses even the smallest worry. For her, dermatology is inseparable from identity and emotional well-being. By ensuring patients feel heard and understood, she creates a foundation of trust that often marks the true beginning of their healing journey. Alongside her clinical practice, Dr Nandini is a respected academician and mentor. With over 23 publications, numerous national conference lectures, BDS research grant, and experience guiding 4 ICMR-funded research projects, she continues to influence the future of dermatology in India. She has also served as Principal Investigator in multiple clinical trials involving biologics for psoriasis, chronic spontaneous urticaria, acne, and atopic dermatitis, contributing valuable scientific data to Indian dermatology. Her expertise has earned her invitations as faculty and panelist at regional, state and national dermatology conferences, reflecting widespread professional respect. Dr Nandini has held several prominent roles, including President of the Bangalore Dermatological Society (BDS), where she launched the impactful “BDS Bus Awareness Programme” with the message: “Healthy Skin is Beautiful Skin – not just Skin Colour”. This initiative addressed societal colourism and promoted healthy skin practices for Indian skin types. Dr. Nandini has received

multiple awards for clinical excellence, scientific contributions, and dermatology advocacy, including the Times Now Doctor's Day Conclave Award (2025) and the Best Case Report Award by IJDVL. In June 2025, she was honoured at the ET Doctor's Day Conclave in New Delhi as one of India's "Inspiring Dermatologists". Fluent in English, Kannada, and Hindi, she ensures seamless communication and trust among patients of varied backgrounds. Driven by ethical responsibility, scientific rigour, and compassionate communication, Dr. Nandini continues to lead dermatology forward through patient-centred care, community advocacy, and academic innovation.
