He is currently practising as an Associate Consultant – Orthopaedics at Manipal Hospital Malleshwaram, where he delivers comprehensive, evidence-based musculoskeletal care. Recognised for his sound surgical judgement and thorough patient evaluations, Dr. Abhishek is regarded as one of the best orthopaedic doctors in Malleshwaram, Bangalore. Dr. Abhishek completed his MBBS from Mysore Medical College and Research Institute (MMCRI) in 2016. He then earned his MS in Orthopaedics from A.J. Institute of Medical Sciences, Mangalore, in 2021. Demonstrating a strong commitment to surgical refinement, he completed a Fellowship in Joint Replacement Surgery (FIJR) and a Fellowship in Arthroscopy and Sports Medicine (FASM) at Manipal Hospital Malleshwaram. He also completed a Fellowship in Advanced Trauma (Travelling) from the Sanjay Gandhi Institute of Trauma and Orthopaedics, Bengaluru, alongside completing the complete AO Trauma education pathway

comprising the Introductory, Basic Principles, Advanced Principles, and Master's Course in Lower Extremity fracture management. At Manipal Hospital Malleshwaram, Dr. Abhishek provides advanced surgical and conservative care across a wide spectrum of orthopaedic conditions. As a top sports injury specialist in Malleshwaram, Bangalore, his surgical repertoire encompasses total knee replacement (TKR), total hip replacement (THR), partial knee replacement (unicompartmental knee replacement), and hemiarthroplasty of the hip. In the field of sports injuries and joint preservation, he performs arthroscopic procedures for ACL, PCL, MCL, LCL, meniscal repairs in the knee, and rotator cuff repairs in the shoulder. His procedural expertise extends to foot and ankle surgery, paediatric trauma surgery, Ilizarov external fixation, limb reconstruction, deformity correction, spine surgery, and musculoskeletal oncology. An active clinical researcher and academician, Dr. Abhishek has authored numerous peer-reviewed publications across reputed indexed journals. His published work covers critical topics such as vancomycin autograft soaking in ACL reconstruction, rotator cuff ultrasound evaluation following humeral nailing, conservative versus surgical outcomes in spinal tuberculosis, and rare musculoskeletal tumours. He has served as faculty in the foot and ankle sessions at major conferences, including OASISCON 2023 and BOSCON 2024.
