Dr. Shalini began her medical journey with an MBBS from St. John's Medical College, Bangalore, where she trained in diverse areas of medicine while developing a special interest in child health. During her fellowship, she gained hands-on expertise in managing critically ill newborns, performing life-saving procedures, and providing comprehensive developmental follow-up for high-risk infants. Over the years, Dr. Shalini has held senior roles across renowned healthcare institutions in Bangalore, including serving as a Senior Registrar at Fortis Hospitals and a Junior Consultant at St. Martha's Hospital. At St. Martha's, she was instrumental in running a 25-bedded Level 3 NICU, establishing high-risk neonatal follow-up clinics, and training both postgraduate residents and nursing staff in evidence-based neonatal care. Since 2015, Dr. Shalini has been practising as a senior consultant, where she established and led a Level 3 NICU unit. For nearly a decade, she has successfully managed some of the most challenging neonatal cases, including extremely low birth weight babies, infants requiring advanced ventilation, and those needing specialised post-operative care. She is especially passionate about breastfeeding support, kangaroo mother care, and the long-term neurodevelopmental follow-up of high-risk newborns, ensuring that infants not only survive but thrive in their early years. Dr Shalini's clinical interests extend beyond acute care to preventive and holistic child health. She provides comprehensive care for paediatric patients, including routine growth and developmental assessments, immunisations, management of common childhood illnesses, and long-term care for chronic conditions. She is also deeply involved in counselling and supporting parents through the often challenging journeys of premature birth, developmental concerns, or chronic health issues. In addition to her clinical work, Dr. Shalini is an active

participant in academic and professional forums. She has presented research at state and national conferences, winning accolades such as the best paper award at the Karnataka State Neonatology Conference. Her work has also been published in peer-reviewed journals, particularly her research on neonatal ventilation and extubation outcomes. She continues to be a certified trainer in neonatal resuscitation and has conducted numerous workshops for medical students, residents, and nursing staff, thereby contributing to the broader medical community.
