Overview

Dr. Vikash Kapoor is a distinguished Director & Senior Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon at Manipal Hospitals, Mukundapur, Kolkata, with over three decades of surgical expertise. He holds an M.B.B.S., M.S. (Ortho), and FSM (Singapore), bringing advanced international training and experience to his practice. Renowned for his extensive expertise in musculoskeletal disorders, sports injuries, and complex joint reconstruction surgeries, Dr. Kapoor has successfully performed over 20,000 joint replacements and 3,000 ACL reconstructions as of 2025. His pioneering role in orthopaedic surgery is exemplified by performing the first bilateral knee replacement (BIL TKR) in Bangladesh and Manipur—an achievement that earned him an invitation as a guest joint replacement surgeon from Bangladesh's former Health Minister. His surgical repertoire includes robotic joint replacements, arthroscopies, and advanced treatments for knee, hip, and shoulder conditions. Dr. Kapoor's specialised approach to sports injuries and joint diseases has made him a trusted name for patients requiring personalised care and cutting-edge procedures. In addition to his surgical accomplishments, Dr. Kapoor is an esteemed academician,

having served as an examiner for the National Board of Examinations (NBE) in Orthopaedics and as the first mentor for the Fellowship of the National Board (FNB) Arthroplasty program in Eastern India. His commitment to academic excellence and surgical innovation has earned him key positions such as Treasurer of the Indian Arthroplasty Society, Secretary and President of the West Bengal Arthroplasty Society, and Executive Committee Member of the Indian Arthroscopy Society. He has completed over 1000 robotic knee replacements in a record time of less than 24 months, setting a benchmark for efficiency and precision in orthopaedic care. His dedication to advancing orthopaedic care has earned Dr. Kapoor multiple accolades, including the prestigious Gold Medal from the U.P. State Chapter of the Indian Orthopaedic Association in 1995 and 1996, the U.P. Chapter Exchange Fellowship in 1996, and the Johnson & Johnson National Fellowship of the Indian Orthopaedic Association in 1998. His expertise spans a wide array of procedures, including robotic joint replacements, ACL reconstructions, and complex shoulder surgeries.
