Her academic and clinical training has been grounded in high-volume tertiary care centres, allowing her to develop a structured and responsive approach to paediatric management. In her clinical practice, Dr. Supriya K is actively involved in general paediatrics, neonatal care, and paediatric intensive care (PICU). She manages a wide spectrum of childhood conditions, ranging from common infections and developmental concerns to complex neonatal and

critical illnesses. Her experience in neonatal ventilation and resuscitation enables her to provide stabilisation and early management for newborns requiring immediate medical attention. Dr. Supriya K has also gained exposure to paediatric neurology through an observership at NIMHANS, Bengaluru, allowing her to better assess and manage neurological presentations such as seizures, developmental delays, and acute neurological events in children. Her approach integrates clinical observation, diagnostic interpretation, and early referral when required, ensuring continuity of care. Her academic contributions include publications in recognised journals, such as a Guillain-Barré Syndrome case study in the International Journal of Contemporary Paediatrics and research on acute cerebellar ataxia in the Asian Journal of Paediatric Research. She has also presented clinical work at South Pedicon 2022, reflecting her engagement in academic discussions and continued learning. Fluent in Kannada, English, and Hindi, Dr. Supriya K communicates clearly with both children and caregivers, ensuring that consultations remain informative and reassuring.
