Overview

Dr. Srinivas K is an exceptionally qualified and experienced oral medicine specialist in Bangalore, with over 20+ years of expertise in different areas of oral medicine. He is currently practising as a Consultant - Oral Medicine & Dental Surgeon at Manipal Hospital Old Airport Road, Bangalore. A pioneer in Oral Medicine in South India, Dr. Srinivas established the first dedicated Oral Medicine clinic in the state of Karnataka at this institution in 2003. His career is defined by a commitment to advancing the intellectual core of dentistry through specialised clinical practice and a patient-centric approach to complex oral health challenges. Dr. Srinivas holds prestigious qualifications, including an MDS in Oral Medicine and Radiology, a Fellowship from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons (FDS RCPCS) in Glasgow, and a Diploma in TMJ and Headaches from London. He brings specialist expertise in the management of oral mucosal disease, oral pre-cancer, Temporomandibular Disorders (TMD), and the potentially malignant disorders. He is a leading authority on orofacial pain and TMD, providing integrative pain management and occlusal splint therapy. His clinical scope further extends to the dental management of medically

compromised patients, salivary gland dysfunction, and the treatment of oral complications arising from cancer therapies. This allows him to bridge the gap between systemic health and dental medicine, ensuring comprehensive care for patients with intricate medical histories. Dr. Srinivas's academic contributions are extensive, characterised by a robust research portfolio of 27 publications, 21 of which are indexed in PubMed, and 61 invited lectures at national and international conferences. His research is highly impactful, with significant work published in the Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews regarding the management of taste disturbances. Beyond his journal publications, he has contributed to the academic literature as a textbook author, specifically writing the chapter on "Dermatological Diseases" for the Textbook of Oral Medicine, Oral Diagnosis and Oral Radiology. His dedication to education is also reflected in his 18-year tenure as an undergraduate and postgraduate teacher, shaping the next generation of dental professionals. As a prominent figure in the dental community, Dr. Srinivas's presentations cover critical topics such as the interdisciplinary management of TMJ, infective oral ulcers, and contemporary approaches to oral mucosal lesions. He has been invited to speak at major forums, including the National Oral Cancer Conference and various Indian Dental Association events. Dr. Srinivas has consistently received accolades for his contributions to the field, most notably the Pioneer Award in 2023 for his role in establishing South India's first dedicated Oral Medicine practice. Professionally, Dr. Srinivas has held significant leadership roles, including serving as the Vice-President of the Indian Academy of Oral Medicine and Radiology (IAOMR). Currently, he serves as a Consultant for the Institutional Ethics Committee at the Government Dental College and Research Institute in Bangalore, ensuring ethical standards in clinical research. To stay at the forefront of dental innovation, Dr. Srinivas has engaged in continuous professional development across various disciplines, including implantology, laser safety, and forensic dentistry. He is a Life Member of the IAOMR and the Indian Dental Association, as well as a

member of the European Association of Oral Medicine. A versatile communicator, he is fluent in English, Kannada, Hindi, and Telugu, with additional proficiency in Tamil and Sanskrit.
