It is a one-of-a-kind safety module that he successfully pioneered in association with Manipal Hospitals. For the same reason, he is considered as the foremost consultant Ear Nose

Throat in Oldairportroad, Bangalore. Dr. E. V. Raman is a fellow and member of reputed societies like the Association of Otolaryngologists of India and the Indian Academy of Otolaryngology and Head and Neck Surgery. He is also a member of the Aerospace Medicine Society of India and the Indian Society of Otology. He is also the Chief Architect of the Center for Otitis Media Research and Education (CORE). Through this role, he is working on spreading awareness about the causes and treatments of middle ear infections. He is registered with the Punjab Medical Council as well.
