Overview

Dr. Shalina Ray is an ENT consultant based in Bangalore. She is currently associated with the Manipal Hospital located at Old Airport Road in the city. She is a head and neck surgeon with a rich experience of more than 16 years. She is an expert in performing surgeries like advanced endoscopic surgery for the sinus, microscopic reconstructive surgery of the ears, laser laryngeal surgery for treating voice disorders, and surgeries for snoring and sleep apnoea. Dr. Ray has done MBBS, MS in ENT, and DLO. She completed her MS from the reputed BJ Medical College located in Ahmedabad. She has done her MRCS from the Royal College of Physicians situated in London, United Kingdom. She also did her DOHNS from the same country. After completing her education, Dr. Shalina Ray stayed in the United Kingdom and worked in the National Health System for 6 years. She took training in advanced Otology from Los Angeles California, at the House Ear Institute. She was at the Singapore General Hospital for training in advanced endoscopic sinus surgeries. She stayed in England to get special training in surgeries like coblation surgeries, tonsillectomy, and adenoidectomy. She worked at KEM Hospital in Mumbai for learning laser surgery and laryngeal voice surgery. For the same reason, she is considered the foremost ENT doctor in Old Airport Road. Dr. Ray has a membership of the Tata Memorial Hospital located in Mumbai. She is a

member of the Royal College of Surgeons from England. She also has a membership in the Karnataka Medical Council and the General Medicine Council of England. Dr. Ray is especially interested in paediatric ENT surgeries. She has also worked on evaluating and managing vertigo, hearing loss, nasal allergies, and tinnitus. She has performed several thyroid surgeries and neck surgeries. She has dealt with nasal bleeding management, obstruction management, removal of foreign bodies in ENT, and surgeries for snoring assisted with radiofrequency. Dr. Shalina Ray's field of expertise covers the following areas: Endoscopic Advanced Sinus Surgery (treatment of Orbital and Skull Base Lesions); Coblation Tonsillectomy and Adenoidectomy; Microscopic Reconstructive Ear Surgery; Laser-Assisted Laryngeal Surgery for Voice Disorders; Surgeries for Snoring and Sleep Apnoea Coblation; and Thyroid and Head and Neck Surgeries. Dr. Ray's articles have been published in many medical journals and websites. She has written about intranasal myopericytoma, severe laryngitis due to steroid abuse, Epistaxis, the sensitivity of barium swallow, etc. Her articles have been published in journals like the Indian Journal of Otolaryngology and Head and Neck Surgery and the European Archives of Oto-Rhino Laryngology. She has worked on a case report about hyperbaric oxygen therapy for patients suffering from COVID-19 that was published in the International Journal of Medical Science and Current Research, and about the Chylous Cyst presented as a supraclavicular mass.
