He is an expert in the field of managing and modification of obesity and lifestyle diseases. He is a part of the Indian chapter of the Spinal Cord Society. He has treated common injuries like ankle sprains, lower back pain, shoulder pain, joint pain, etc. He gave a lecture about “How to do we Optimise Post Stroke Spasticity Management with Onabotulinumtoxin A” in May 2019 at a workshop on upper limb spasticity. He has experience in treating chronic syndromes such as myofascial pain, fibromyalgia, and lifestyle diseases. He is skilled in performing interventional procedures like nerve simulator-guided BOTOX (Botulinum toxin) injections for spasticity. He has also used intra-articular hyaluronic acid injections and steroids for treating frozen shoulders and osteoarthritis. He gave a lecture about ‘Stroke Rehabilitation’ at Manipal Hospital in the year 2016. Internationally, he has lectured about “Orthotic management and offloading in Diabetic foot” during a course designed by the Schieffelin Institute of Health Research in collaboration with Tameside General Hospital, Lancashire, in the United Kingdom. He was part of a rehabilitation camp organised by the Association of People with Disability in 2012 to provide professional recourse help. He consults patients about neurosurgery, intensive units, rehab planning, and managing neurological pains. He helps critically ill patients return to everyday lifestyles through rehabilitation and pain management.

- Neurorehabilitation: Providing Acute to sub-acute consultation for stroke, Brain injuries and other neurological conditions admitted in the Neurology, Neurosurgery and intensive units, making comprehensive rehab planning including management of neurogenic bladder and bowel, Musculoskeletal pain, prevention and treatment of pressure ulcers, spasticity and contractures and supervising early mobilization of the critically ill patients and their return to the functional capacity.
- Chronic neurological conditions like spastic hemiplegia, GBS, Traumatic brain injury and spinal cord injury.
- Musculoskeletal pain conditions like low back ache, neck pain, shoulder and other joint pain and their management using pharmacological and non-pharmacological methods.
- Management of sports specific injuries especially ankle and foot related pathologies like sprains, tendonitis, fasciitis etc.
- Chronic pain syndromes like fibromyalgia, myofascial pain, chronic fatigue syndromes and lifestyle related conditions like obesity.
- Interventional procedures like Botulinum toxin (BOTOX) injections (nerve stimulator guided) for spasticity and intra articular injections like steroid and hyaluronic acid for chronic and painful conditions like frozen shoulder, osteoarthritis of knee.
