### **Overview**

Mr. Mohan Dass G. (PT) is a specialised paediatric physiotherapist in Old Airport Road whose clinical practice is centred on early intervention, neurodevelopmental rehabilitation, and structured functional recovery in infants and young children. He is currently practising as an Executive – Senior Paediatric Physiotherapist at Manipal Hospital Old Airport Road, where he delivers focused, evidence-based therapy programmes for high-risk infants and children with complex developmental and neurological needs. With a Master's qualification in Neuro Sciences and extensive advanced certifications, Mr. Mohan Dass brings a depth of paediatric rehabilitation expertise that spans motor development, sensory integration, respiratory physiotherapy, and functional vision therapy. A defining aspect of his professional profile is his distinction as the first certified practitioner in Bengaluru and South India for Dynamic Movement Intervention (DMI Therapy), having completed Introductory Level A, Level B, and Level C training through the DMI Therapy Institute, Ontario, Canada. DMI is a high-level paediatric intervention used to facilitate postural control, alignment, and purposeful movement in infants and children with

neurological and genetic conditions. His structured application of DMI supports early milestone acquisition and functional independence in children who require intensive motor rehabilitation. He is also the first certified practitioner in the region for Total Motion Release (TMR – TOTS), a paediatric-specific system that addresses asymmetrical movement patterns and functional restrictions in infants and toddlers. Mr. Mohan Dass has advanced training in neurodevelopmental therapy, sensory integration therapy, neonatal and infantile tactile massage, functional vision therapy, and cough assist therapy. He is certified in Prechtl's General Movement Assessment, Bayley Scales of Infant and Toddler Development (BSID-IV), Developmental Assessment Scales for Indian Infants (DASII-2), and the Test for Infant Motor Performance. These assessment tools form the foundation of his clinical decision-making, allowing therapy goals to be individualised, measurable, and developmentally appropriate. His clinical scope includes high-risk infant follow-up, particularly for preterm infants, neonates with neurological compromise, and children with complex medical backgrounds. In paediatric pulmonary rehabilitation, he is experienced in airway clearance techniques, mechanical insufflation–exsufflation (MI:E cough assist therapy), and respiratory physiotherapy for children with neuromuscular and chronic pulmonary conditions. His work continues to emphasise timely assessment, precise intervention, and functional outcomes, reinforcing his role among the best paediatric physiotherapist in Old Airport Road for infants and children requiring specialised rehabilitative care. At Manipal Hospital Old Airport Road, Mr. Mohan Dass works closely with neonatologists, paediatricians, paediatric neurologists, pulmonologists, and rehabilitation teams to ensure coordinated, child-centred care. His therapy sessions are characterised by careful handling, structured progression, and consistent caregiver education. Parents are actively involved in goal setting and home programmes, enabling continuity of care beyond the clinical setting. His calm manner with children and clear communication with families help build trust, making him one of the

best paediatric physiotherapist in Old Airport Road for early intervention and neurodevelopmental rehabilitation.
