He is particularly skilled in complex reconstructive surgeries for cancer patients, including head and neck reconstruction, breast reconstruction, and limb salvage procedures using advanced microsurgical techniques. Dr. Puranik also specialises in procedures such as lymphoedema surgery, facial palsy surgery, aesthetic surgery and complex reconstructive surgeries following trauma. His approach focuses on restoring both function and aesthetics, helping patients regain confidence and improve their quality of life. By combining meticulous surgical precision with an artistic understanding of form and symmetry, he ensures natural and functional outcomes in both reconstructive and cosmetic procedures.
