Express Healthcare published his article on the treatment and prevalence of coronary artery calcification. Dr. Sridhara is the best cardiologist in Old Airport Road. Dr. Sridhara has gained experience working as an interventionist for coronary and structural heart diseases. He has saved many lives by performing many primary percutaneous interventions for patients suffering from heart attacks. He also specialises in cardiac electrophysiology for the treatment of cardiac arrhythmias. He is experienced in performing cardiac electronic device implantations, which include setting up pacemakers of CRT-P and CRT-D types. He is also an expert in the paediatric catheterisation procedure, including device closure.
