With a robust clinical foundation and hands-on expertise in managing complex and high-risk cases, Dr. Singh is proficient in a wide range of intensive care procedures, making him a trusted name in critical care in Ranchi. He is highly skilled in life-saving protocols such as ACLS and ATLS and routinely performs procedures including endotracheal intubations, invasive and noninvasive ventilation, emergency cricothyrotomy, and percutaneous tracheostomy. His expertise extends to central venous catheter placement via femoral, subclavian, and jugular routes; temporary cardiac pacing; CVP monitoring; and arterial cannulation. Dr. Singh is experienced in conducting and managing pleural tapping, ICD insertion and maintenance, abdominal paracentesis, lumbar puncture, and both peritoneal dialysis and haemodialysis, including

catheter insertion and dialysis management. Additionally, he is trained in pre- and post-operative renal transplantation care and has advanced skills in bedside echocardiography, ultrasound applications in ICU settings, and bronchoscopy. His procedural precision and evidence-based approach contribute significantly to the management of critically ill patients requiring ventilator support, multi-organ monitoring, and rapid intervention. As a core member of the hospital's critical care team, Dr. Singh plays a pivotal role in reducing ICU mortality rates and enhancing patient recovery outcomes. infrastructure.
