Overview

Dr. Pramod is a super-specialist surgical gastroenterologist in Whitefield, Bengaluru, with over 14 years of experience in gastrointestinal and hepatopancreato-biliary surgery. He is currently practising as a Consultant – Surgical Gastroenterology at Manipal Hospitals, Varthur Road, Whitefield, with advanced expertise in GI oncology, hepato-pancreato-biliary (HPB) surgery, and minimally invasive gastrointestinal procedures. He completed his MBBS from Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, followed by MS in General Surgery from JIPMER, Pondicherry, and DNB in General Surgery. He subsequently pursued DNB in Surgical Gastroenterology from the National Board of Examinations, training at Manipal Hospital, Bengaluru. This progression from general surgery to super-specialty gastrointestinal surgery reflects structured surgical training in both open and minimally invasive techniques. Dr. Pramod's clinical scope includes gastrointestinal surgeries, HPB surgeries, and laparoscopic and minimal access procedures. His expertise spans surgeries for acute and chronic pancreatitis, laparoscopic and open procedures for liver tumours and liver cancer, and surgeries for gall bladder stones

and gall bladder cancer. He performs surgical correction of bile duct injuries and complex biliary strictures, pancreatic cyst and pancreatic cancer surgeries, and advanced operations for esophago-gastric diseases, including cancers of the food pipe and stomach. His involvement in complex oncological procedures contributes to his recognition as one of the best surgical gastroenterologists in Varthur Road, Whitefield for GI cancer and HPB surgery. His practice also includes laparoscopic surgery for GERD and hiatal hernia, minimally invasive surgery for achalasia cardia, and surgical management of small intestinal diseases such as tuberculosis and Crohn's disease. In colorectal surgery, he performs laparoscopic surgery for colon and rectal cancer, surgical treatment for ulcerative colitis, correction of complex fistula-in-ano, recto-vaginal and recto-vesical fistula repairs, and surgeries for rectal prolapse and anal incontinence. His surgical range further includes bariatric and metabolic surgery, operations for portal hypertension and upper GI bleed, emergency surgery for blunt and penetrating abdominal trauma, splenic injuries and tumours, and surgeries for small intestinal tumours and obstruction. Academically, he has presented papers and posters at IASGCON and other surgical forums and has published work, including research on intraoperative peritoneal candida in perforation peritonitis. His involvement in liver transplantation during his super-specialty training further strengthened his HPB exposure. Fluent in English, Hindi, Kannada, Tamil, and Telugu, he communicates clearly during consultations, ensuring that complex gastrointestinal conditions are explained with clarity and structure. Through sustained surgical experience in GI oncology, HPB surgery, and minimally invasive gastrointestinal procedures, Dr. Pramod is widely regarded as one of the best surgical gastroenterologists in Varthur Road, Whitefield, particularly for comprehensive gastrointestinal and cancer-related surgical care.
