After completing his MBBS in 2003 from K.A.P.V. Government Medical College, Trichy, he pursued his MS in General Surgery at Kasturba Medical College, Manipal, followed by an academic appointment as Assistant Professor in the Department of General Surgery. He later completed his MCh in Urology from Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai, refining his focus on specialised urological surgery. Dr. Anand manages a broad spectrum of urological disorders, ranging from renal stone disease and benign prostatic enlargement to complex reconstructive and transplant procedures. His expertise in advanced endo-urology includes minimally invasive stone surgeries using laser technology, percutaneous and ureteroscopic interventions, and structured management of obstructive uropathy. In

prostate care, he performs laser procedures designed to optimise urinary flow while reducing recovery time and perioperative morbidity. His surgical depth and structured approach position him among the best urologists in Varthur Road, Whitefield for advanced endoscopic and laser-based interventions. His proficiency extends to robotic and advanced laparoscopic urology, allowing precise dissection, improved visualisation, and enhanced surgical control in selected cases. In renal transplantation, he contributes to both donor and recipient surgical pathways, ensuring meticulous vascular and ureteric reconstruction within a multidisciplinary transplant framework. His practice emphasises accurate preoperative assessment, intraoperative precision, and structured postoperative monitoring to optimise functional outcomes.
