Dr. Rohit N. Maidur is a highly accomplished gastroenterologist in Bangalore. He is currently working as a Chief Consultant - Medical Gastroenterology and Hepatology at Manipal Hospitals Varthur Road, Bangalore. With over 15 years of clinical experience, he brings expertise in the diagnosis, management, and treatment of gastrointestinal and liver diseases, offering comprehensive care to patients with complex digestive and hepatic conditions. His career reflects a rare balance of advanced clinical practice, dedicated teaching, and active research contributions that have enriched the field of gastroenterology both in India and abroad. Having earned his MBBS from Mysore Medical College, followed by MD in Internal Medicine from Karnataka Institute of Medical Sciences, Hubli, and a DNB in Medical Gastroenterology from the prestigious Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad, Dr. Rohit has built a strong academic foundation. His training years allowed him to gain exposure to challenging cases in hepatology, critical care of cirrhosis, and advanced endoscopy. During his residency and fellowship, he also developed specialised skills in pancreatology, IBD management, and

liver disease outcomes research, which continue to shape his clinical practice. At Manipal Hospitals, Varthur, Dr. Rohit's expertise covers a wide range of subspecialties within gastroenterology and hepatology. He is proficient in managing viral hepatitis (B and C), acute liver failure, and chronic liver diseases, with an emphasis on patient-centred approaches such as education, counselling, and nutritional guidance. His work in hepatology has also extended to transplant-related care, as he earlier shouldered the responsibility of managing the Liver Clinic at Hyderabad, which runs a deceased-donor liver transplant programme. Dr. Rohit is also highly skilled in diagnostic and therapeutic GI endoscopy. His expertise spans emergency procedures such as GI bleed management and foreign body removal, as well as advanced therapeutic procedures, including ERCP, EUS, and third-space endoscopy. He performs around four ERCPs weekly and is adept in therapeutic EUS, making him one of the few specialists in Bangalore with significant hands-on expertise in advanced endoscopic interventions. Before joining Manipal Hospital Varthur, Dr. Rohit held senior teaching and consultant positions. He served as Associate Professor and later Assistant Professor at a renowned College of Medical Sciences, Dharwad, where he trained postgraduate students and fellows in gastroenterology and hepatology. His academic career is distinguished by his commitment to knowledge-sharing, having taken active roles in conducting lectures, clinical demonstrations, and workshops for medical students, residents, and nursing staff. His research portfolio is equally impressive, with multiple publications in peer-reviewed international and national journals, particularly in hepatology and inflammatory bowel disease. Notably, he has co-authored landmark studies on hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC), portal hypertension due to genetic disorders, and the outcomes of cirrhotic patients in critical care. He has also contributed to global discussions through poster presentations at international conferences, including the International Digestive Disease Forum in Hong Kong and the Asia-Pacific Association for the Study of Liver Disease. In recognition of his

academic and clinical excellence, Dr. Rohit has been an active member of leading professional associations, including the Indian National Association for the Study of the Liver (INASL), the Indian Society of Gastroenterology (ISG), and the Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy of India (SGEI). His organising roles in conferences such as ISGKCON 2022 and World Hepatitis Day programmes highlight his dedication to professional development and community awareness. Known for his empathetic patient care, clear communication, and commitment to medical education, Dr. Rohit is regarded as a physician who combines clinical acumen with a compassionate approach.
