Dr. Ravikiran Andra is a highly skilled general and laparoscopic surgeon, currently practising as a Specialist - General, Laparoscopic and Minimal Access Surgery at Manipal Hospital Varthur Road. With a strong foundation in both conventional and minimally invasive surgical techniques, Dr. Ravikiran brings a comprehensive approach to the management of surgical conditions, blending modern innovations with evidence-based clinical practice to aid in patient comfort, safety, and quicker recovery. Having completed his MBBS from Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences, Bengaluru, Dr. Ravikiran went on to pursue his MS in General Surgery from Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Belagavi, and subsequently earned a DNB in General Surgery. His academic pathway reflects rigorous training and a commitment to excellence in surgery. Further enhancing his expertise, Dr. Ravikiran completed a Fellowship in Minimal Access Surgery (FMAS) from the Association of Minimal Access Surgeons of India, one of the most sought-after certifications in advanced laparoscopic surgery. His training has enabled him to offer cutting-edge surgical interventions that are less invasive, reduce hospital stay, and improve patient quality of life. Dr. Ravikiran's

expertise covers a broad spectrum of surgical problems. He routinely performs laparoscopic gallbladder removal (cholecystectomy), appendix surgery (appendicectomy), and hernia repairs, including inguinal, umbilical, ventral and incisional hernias through both open and laparoscopic techniques. He offers laparoscopic fundoplication surgery for patients with gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD) and hiatal hernia, which has benefited many patients suffering from chronic reflux-related problems, particularly among working professionals with high-stress lifestyles. In addition, he is adept in colorectal procedures, breast surgeries (including lumpectomy and mastectomy for both benign and malignant conditions), and thyroid surgery. Dr. Ravikiran has significant expertise in proctology, managing conditions such as piles, fistula in ano, and pilonidal sinus with advanced methods that minimise discomfort and recurrence. He regularly undertakes minor OPD-based procedures such as cyst excision, lipoma removal, abscess drainage, and wound care, enabling timely intervention and preventing complications. He also participates in surgical outreach camps, bringing quality surgical care to rural communities that often lack access to advanced treatment. His training in Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) from the American College of Surgeons further strengthens his capabilities to manage surgical emergencies with international standards of care. In addition to his clinical excellence, Dr. Ravikiran is deeply engaged in academic research and professional development. He has presented papers and posters at major national conferences, including ASICON, where his work has been recognised with awards such as the Best Free Paper Award (2022, Mumbai) and the Best Poster Award (2021). His research contributions include studies on hernia repair techniques, laparoscopic management of gastrointestinal conditions, and case reports on rare surgical presentations like splenic hydatid cysts, choledochal cysts, and diaphragmatic hernia with volvulus. Dr. Ravikiran maintains active memberships with leading professional bodies such as the Association

of Surgeons of India (ASI), the Indian Association of Gastrointestinal Endo-Surgeons (IAGES), and the Association of Minimal Access Surgeons of India (AMASI).
