Overview

Dr. Mohammad Abbas is a highly skilled intensivist in Varthur Road, Bengaluru. He is currently practising as a Consultant – Critical Care Medicine (ICU) at Manipal Hospital Varthur Road, Bangalore, bringing advanced clinical expertise in high-acuity critical care, extracorporeal life support, and transplant critical care to complex, life-threatening conditions. With a strong focus on precision-driven, evidence-based ICU care, he is regarded as one of the best intensivists in Varthur Road. Dr. Abbas holds an MBBS and an MD, followed by a DrNB in Critical Care Medicine. His research appears in journals such as Anaesthesia Essays and Researches, Critical Care Communications (ISCCM), Indian Journal of Respiratory Care, Indian Journal of Intensive Care Case Reports, Al Ameen Journal of Medical Sciences, and IJIRMS. At Manipal Hospital Varthur Road, Dr. Abbas delivers comprehensive ICU care for high-risk medical, surgical, transplant, and trauma patients.
