Her clinical focus includes advanced mechanical ventilation, shock management, neurocritical care, transplant critical care, and complex trauma management, ensuring comprehensive treatment for critically ill patients. Dr. Sapna Jain completed her MBBS from JSS Medical College, Mysore, under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, followed by a DNB in Anaesthesiology from Bangalore Baptist Hospital. She further specialised in critical care by completing the Indian Diploma in Critical Care Medicine (IDCCM) and has also cleared the European Diploma in Intensive Care (EDIC) Part 1, reflecting her advanced training in intensive care medicine. Additionally, she holds a Diploma in Transplant Procurement Management, strengthening her expertise in transplant-related critical

care and organ donation processes. With several years of experience in leading hospitals, Dr. Sapna has worked across multiple intensive care units, managing complex and life-threatening conditions, actively participating in ICU management, emergency response teams, and critical care procedures where she gained extensive experience in managing critically ill patients requiring advanced life support and multidisciplinary care.
