Overview

Dr. Garima Aggarwal is an accomplished nephrologist in Whitefield, Bangalore. She is currently practising as a Consultant – Nephrology and Renal Transplant Physician at Manipal Hospital Whitefield, bringing over 14+ years of clinical experience across advanced kidney care, renal transplantation, and critical care nephrology. Her clinical practice is centred on the management of complex kidney diseases, including advanced chronic kidney disease, reversible acute kidney injury, and a wide spectrum of glomerular disorders. She is extensively involved in renal transplantation, with hands-on experience in live-related and unrelated transplants, deceased donor programmes, and complex cases such as ABO-incompatible, high immunological risk, and multi-organ transplants. After completing her MBBS, Dr. Garima did her MD in Internal Medicine from the Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, where she was a gold medallist. She then pursued a DM in Nephrology with top rank from Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences. Her postgraduate training included extensive exposure to transplant immunology, interventional nephrology, dialysis technologies, and the care of highly complex renal and multi-organ transplant patients. She

further refined her academic and clinical depth through a clinical externship at Christian Medical College, Vellore, under Professor John Feehally, a globally recognised authority in nephrology. As one of the best nephrologists in Whitefield, Dr. Garima has played a key role in organising the first ABO-incompatible transplant at Manipal Hospitals Varthur Road unit, which makes her practice distinctively programme-driven rather than limited to individual case care. Her current responsibilities include conducting daily nephrology outpatient clinics, managing inpatient referrals, and performing a wide range of procedures such as renal and graft biopsies, permcath and haemodialysis catheter insertions, peritoneal dialysis catheter placements, and critical care nephrology interventions. Her earlier leadership roles involved managing large dialysis units, supervising DNB nephrology training programmes, and coordinating multidisciplinary transplant care pathways. Beyond clinical practice, Dr. Garima has a strong academic footprint. She is the editor of the Textbook of Nephrology – Understanding Kidney Diseases and co-editor of Renal Replacement Therapy by Jaypee Publishers. She is also a co-author of the National Guidelines on Anaemia of Chronic Kidney Disease in India, published in the Indian Journal of Nephrology. Her work includes multiple national and international publications, invited faculty roles at major conferences, and editorial and peer-review contributions to indexed nephrology journals. Being one of the best nephrologists in Whitefield, Dr. Garima has been recognised nationally for her contributions to kidney medicine, including being awarded by the Indian Medical Association for Academic Excellence in Kidney Care and being listed among the Best Nephrologists in South India by an independent jury. As one of the nephrologists in Whitefield, Bangalore, actively shaping both clinical standards and academic discourse, her work continues to bridge advanced patient care, transplant programme development, and national-level kidney health advocacy.
