He also has an MS in General Surgery, which he completed from the Grant Medical College and Sir JJ Hospital of Mumbai in 1997. He was the Consultant Colorectal Surgeon at St Richard's Hospital in West Sussex for 1 year. He was the Higher

Surgical Trainee in the field of PGMDE at Oxford Deanery as well. Dr. Shashidhara G. Matta is a part of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow and has their membership too. He is associated with the General Medical Council of the United Kingdom. Dr. Shashidhara is the best general surgery specialist in Whitefield, Bangalore. Dr. Shashidhara G. Matta got a 6th rank in merit during his final MBBS exams at the University of Mysore. He also got a distinction, i.e. more than 75% marks in biochemistry, pharmacology, physiology, and anatomy.
