This expertise allows him to go beyond treating injuries reactively, enabling him to identify risk factors in movement patterns and correct them before they translate into performance limitations or injuries. His recent publication, "A Biomechanical Study of Drag Flick and Hit in Indian Field Hockey: Implications on Lumbar Spine and Hip Injury" in the Journal of Orthopaedic Reports (2025), is a pioneering contribution to understanding overuse injuries in hockey players. He has also presented his work at several prestigious platforms, including the Asian Federation of Sports Medicine Congress, the World Congress of Science and Medicine in Cricket, and the Sports Medicine Australia Conference, where his insights on injury patterns, biomechanics, and rehabilitation strategies have been well-received. As a former athlete himself, Dr. Shishir brings a unique understanding of the physical and psychological demands of competitive sport. This background shapes his patient care philosophy, where he integrates evidence-based medicine with empathy and a practical understanding of athlete life. His certification in ATLS, BLS, and ACLS ensures he is
