She also co-authored rare and complex case studies, including anaesthesia management for Hydrolethalus syndrome and an epidural blood patch in a patient with subdural haematoma—both featured in reputed anaesthesia journals. Dr. Bharathi Hosdurg is a respected member of the Indian Society of Anaesthesia and continuously engages in knowledge-sharing and academic forums. Her scientific approach to anaesthesia, backed by clinical experience and evidence-based practice, ensures that patients receive optimal care grounded in the latest medical advancements.
