Overview

Dr. Rajesh Mohan Shetty is a Consultant in Critical Care Medicine at the Manipal Hospital located in the Whitefield area of Bangalore City. He is a highly-educated doctor with reputed national and international degrees and fellowships in the field of critical care medicine. He has worked as a critical care specialist for more than 10 years now. Apart from his consulting work, he is also interested in doing research in his field. Dr. Shetty is also an expert in Echocardiography and critical care sonography. He specialises in giving advanced cardiac life support and Extracorporeal Life Support (ECMO) to critically ill patients. He is a member of the Extracorporeal Life Support Organization and the Indian Society of Critical Care Medicine. He won the Level 1 Clinical Excellence Award in the year 2012 in London. He is a member of the General Medical Council of the United Kingdom and has a fellowship given by the Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh as well. During the COVID-19 pandemic, he talked about using ECMO for COVID recovery, the bed crisis in Karnataka, the linkage between brain death and organ donation, and the use of corticosteroids in treating non-severe cases of COVID-19. He has contributed to a book about intensive care that has 1000 MCQs about the topic. He wrote a chapter about hemodynamics in the 'Critical Care Update 2021'. He has written a handbook about COVID-19 care along with other doctors and also wrote about managing severe COVID-19 cases. He is fluent in speaking English, Kannada, Tulu, and Hindi languages.
