His clinical expertise spans neurotrauma, neuro-oncology, spine surgery, and paediatric neurosurgery. He has authored peer-reviewed papers in recognised journals, including work on surgical techniques for chronic subdural haematoma and intraoperative cerebrospinal fluid glucose monitoring.
